



## PHOTOGRAPHY POLICY

---

### Purpose

This Policy addresses the acquisition and display of images of persons, including children and young people, participating in netball activities run by and/or associated with Palmerston Netball Association (PNA).

### Policy

- 1 The privacy of others will be respected.
- 2 Every person and affiliated club should, wherever possible, obtain permission from a child's parent/guardian before taking an image of a child that is not their own.
- 3 Cameras are prohibited from being used within toilets, showers and changerooms at the Palmerston netball courts and any venue at which PNA is represented.
- 4 All images taken by PNA will be used appropriately and legally at all times. This means images will not be indecent, defamatory, used for voyeurism or made for the purpose of observing and/or visually recording a person's genital or anal region. Images will not knowingly be taken of any person protected by a court order (e.g. child custody or witness protection).
- 5 PNA will only use appropriate and positive images of a suitably clothed person that are relevant to and promote participation in the sport of netball.
- 6 PNA will not display personal or sensitive information.
- 7 Parents/guardians shall notify PNA in writing if their child's image is to be excluded from publication. PNA will undertake its best efforts to satisfy this request.
- 8 All persons are required to inform the PNA Management Team and/or Police immediately if they have concerns regarding a person taking inappropriate or intrusive photography at PNA premises or during PNA activities.
- 9 Where a person is believed to be inappropriately photographing, PNA has the right to ask them to cease immediately. If they refuse, PNA has the right to ask them to leave the premises and/or inform the Police.
